Project Background

- Laveen area is subject to chronic flooding
- September 2014 storms caused major damage



Project Goals & Meeting Purpose

- Mitigate risk of local and regional flooding
- Protect life and property
- Inform the community



Improvement Efforts to Date

- Laveen Area Drainage Master Plan Update (2017)
- District/City constructed basin at 27th & South Mountain Aves (2017)
- District/City constructed local basins near 23rd
 Ave. & Olney Dr (2019)
- District/City will construct storm drain along 27th Ave, Olney Dr (est. 2022)
- Other City improvements post-2014 storms

Elements of This Project

- Storm drain
 - 2 miles
 - Size ranges from 54 to 72 inches
 - Crosses under SRP Western Canal
 - Discharge into South Mountain Basin
- Dobbins Basin on City-owned property

Project Impacts

- Benefits
 - Reduces flooding to existing structures
 - Mitigates overall community flood risk
 - Storm drain will be within existing rightsof-way
 - Reduces regulatory floodplain on City WSD parcel




Project Impacts

- Constraints
 - Local traffic disruptions during construction
 - Must cross beneath the SRP Western Canal at Dobbins Road
 - Requires drainage improvements at Dobbins Road & 15th Avenue
 - Roadway enhancements not included
